## Pistol Range Rules

The following rules have been adopted to insure a safe and enjoyable shooting experience for all visitors

## 1. OBEY ALL COMMANDS OF THE RANGE SAFETY OFFICER AT ALL TIMES

- 2. Any shooter displaying unsafe or disruptive behavior will be asked to cease fire and may be asked to leave the range
- 3. Appropriate eye and ear protection must be worn before entering the range
- 4. Bring firearms in a case. No uncasing or handling of firearms until at the firing line
- 5. Keep all guns pointed down range at ALL times whether loaded or not
- 6. All guns must be unloaded with actions/cylinders open while on shooting bench when not firing
- 7. No drawing from a holster is allowed, never point guns at the floor
- 8. No rapid fire allowed. Timed fire is one shot per second or slower
- 9. All targets must be carefully positioned at **7 yards** (grey line) or more to insure bullets impact the grey steel backstop, not the floor or roof
- 10. Range fees are for 1 hour or any part of 1 hour
- 11. No magnum, high power or black powder loads are allowed. This includes .357SIG, 10MM, 5.7mmx24, .30 carbine
- 12. Centerfire, pistol caliber rifles are allowed
- 13. Shooters are responsible for any damage to target clips, rods, lights, roof, etc.
- 14. No steel jacket or steel projectile ammo allowed. Please check ammo with a magnet to be sure
- 15. No food or drinks allowed in the range.
- 16. Please remove targets and pick up empty brass cases before leaving the range
- 17. Minors are allowed when accompanied by legal guardian, minimum age will be determined on a case by case basis by the RSO
